Please bring with you to class:

- **Charcoal** – vine and hard; CHARKOLE brand if you can find—very black and soft
- **Pencils** – a variety of leads – from 6H to 8B as well as good sketching pencils and colored pencils whatever you may have
- **Erasers** – Faber Magic-Rub, Kneaded, ArtGum and Pink Pearl – they all do different things
- **Crayons** – regular Crayola, cray-pas, oil crayons and/or oil sticks
- **Ink/s** – black (essential) and colors if you have and any **Watercolor** kits or tubes you have
- **Brushes** – all types – soft and hard bristles – Japanese brushes, fan brushes and some large ones -1'2" hardware store cheap, foam brushes also cheap
- **Papers** – large 18" x 24" Newsprint pad and a variety of decent papers (hard and soft surfaces) that can be worked with Inks, liquids, collage
- **Glues** - Glue sticks are good but the best for collage is YES Paste- available at Dick Blick – great stuff!
- **Scissors, mat knife and/or Xacto knife**
- **Latex gloves** - if you want to keep clean hands - not required

If anyone wants to also use Acrylic paint, gouache or Flashe' feel free to bring but it's not required.

You do not have to have every single thing on this list but some of everything will help!

We're sorry, but you cannot put contaminated liquid down the drains! Please take home any solvents or paint mediums after your workshop. Rags are provided for clean up, and must be disposed in the proper fire-safe bins if used. Thank you for your cooperation!
