From Collage to Painting

Please bring with you to class:

FOR COLLAGED SKETCHES:

- All kinds of magazines/books you like that can be cut up. Any other materials you may like to use for collages.
- Scissors, X-Acto Knife, Cutting Board, Glue, Mounting Surface.

FOR PAINTINGS:

- Gesso primed canvas, panel or hardboard (choose sizes you personally feel comfortable with)
- Minimum brushes: 4 brushes. Fine, Small, Med, Large (e.g. Princeton Select Liner Petit 20/0, Princeton Select Angular Shaders ¼", ½", 1")
- Minimum Paints: Acrylic tube paints, oil paints or alkyd paints.
- 2 yellows (1. lemon yellow OR cadmium yellow pale, AND 2. cadmium yellow medium)
- 2 reds (1. quinacridone red AND 2. cadmium red light)
- 3 blues (Magnesium Blue, Prussian blue, Payne Gray)
- Yellow Ochre, Burnt Umber, Mars Black
- Titanium White
- For Oil Painting: odorless mineral spirits
- For Acrylic painting: Acrylic Extender Polymer Mediums, Retarder or Open Medium.
- Palette: disposable paper palettes, white, glass, or ceramic palette for oils, plastic OK for acrylic.
- Paper towels, Kleenex, clean soft cotton rags, glass jars (2-3 med size)
- Painting knife
- Sketchpad or paper, pencil, eraser, ultra-fine point black Sharpie.

*Wear old clothes or bring a shirt or apron to protect your clothes.

We're sorry, but you cannot put contaminated liquid down the drains! Please take home any solvents or paint mediums after your workshop. Rags are provided for clean up, and must be disposed of in the proper fire-safe bins if used. Thank you for your cooperation!
