Cut, Copy and Paste: A Monoprinting Course

Materials fee covers print studio supplies such as inks, rags, tools and equipment. A selection of paper is also available for sale out of the studio

Please bring with you to class:

- Paper: In this class we will use a lot of paper both for printing on and for printing from. Minimum of 8 sheets 22"x30" hot press printmaking paper suitable for wet media process. (Rives)
 - 1 pack 19x24 newsprint
 - o 3 sheets 19x24 acetate or mylar
 - 1 piece of heavy duty acetate larger than 16x23 for registration systems.
 - Commercial stock (glossy) papers for stencil and offset processes
 - Any other paper you can find suitable for printing, collage, drawing, texture, fabrics, and offset processes.

Other supplies:

- Pronto plates: 3-5 12 x 18" sheets
- Brushes for oils. Flats tend to be the most useful and stiffer brushes generally better. Get a range you are comfortable with. Gather both good and throw away brushes.
- 1 good stencil brush
- Pencils. Get at least one pencil that is very soft. 2B graphite sticks are great.
- Soft charcoal
- Collect cotton rags (old T-shirts), Q-tips, chop sticks, and other random drawing implements
- Watercolors and gouache
- PVA glue and/or spray adhesive
